1. Scope of Agreement

This Agreement governs the submission of data (“Data”) by the Submitter to the Administrator for inclusion in the repository located at <https://www.anpd.org/Resources/Preceptor-Assessment-Tool-PAT-Repository> (the “Repository”).

2. Data Description

Purpose of the ANPD Preceptor Assessment Tool (PAT) Repository

The ANPD PAT Repository serves as a national database for preceptor evaluations. Healthcare organizations can use the repository pursuant to completing the application and an ANPD PAT Repository Agreement. Organizations must submit a 5-item organization code consisting of letters, numbers, or both to be used by all individuals from the organizations who complete the PAT. This identifier allows organizations’ data to be extracted, upon request, from the repository. Aggregate organizational data can be used to evaluate preceptor program effectiveness. Additionally, organizations can provide users with individual department identifiers to allow department assessment. Upon completion of the PAT, individuals can provide an email address to obtain a link to print individual results.

3. Representations and Warranties

The Submitter represents and warrants that:

1. They are the owner or have all necessary rights, permissions, and authority to submit the Data to the Repository.
2. The Data does not infringe on any third-party rights, including intellectual property rights, privacy rights, or confidentiality obligations.
3. The Data complies with all applicable laws and regulations.

4. License Grant

The Submitter grants the Administrator a non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free license to use, store, reproduce, distribute, modify, publicly display, and create derivative works based on the Data, for the purposes of:

5. Data Use and Preservation

1. The Administrator will take reasonable steps to preserve the integrity and security of the Data but does not guarantee permanent storage or accessibility.
2. The Administrator may modify or remove the Data from the Repository at its discretion.

6. Attribution

Researchers who publish studies/projects conducted using data from the repository must acknowledge use of the ANPD PAT Repository.

7. Limitation of Liability

The Administrator assumes no responsibility or liability for any use or misuse of the Data by any party who accesses it through the Repository.

8. Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon 30 days' written notice. Upon termination:

1. The Administrator may retain copies of the Data for archival and legal compliance purposes.

9. Governing Law

This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Florida.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties concerning the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings, whether written or oral.
